We are also keeping the number of people who enter the church to the minimum so that the chances of the virus spreading via human contact are as low as possible.

Although the church as a building is closed and we are not able to meet together as a worshipping community the life of Saint Paul's through prayer, reading of the Bible, and caring for one another carries on.

In the words of the beautiful evening hymn, 'The day thou gavest' ,
