Please make cheques payable to St Paul's Parochial Church Council.

If you are a UK taxpayer, **Gift Aid** allows an extra 20p for each £1 you give St Paul's Church to be reclaimed from HM Revenue and Customs.

If you agree with the following statements and wish your gift to be treated as a **Gift Aid** donation, please sign and date below. Enclose the completed signed and dated page with your donation.

I wish **Gift Aid** to apply to this donation to St. Paul's Church, Charlestown, and I confirm I will pay in this tax year an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the amount that all charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs to which I give will reclaim for this year [25p for each £1 given]. I understand that other taxes such as Council Tax and VAT do not apply.
